Dear Parents/carers,

For our last trip together in Year 3 I have arranged a trip to Cadbury's World, Birmingham.

The day will involve the children exploring the factory and seeing all aspects of how the famous Cadbury's brands are made including watching chocolatiers work with chocolate. We will also be experiencing the 4D interactive cinema. We may even get to taste a bar or two!

There will also be time to visit the factory shop and I would ask that children bring no more than £3.50 as spending money.

The trip will take place on Tuesday 20th June 2017 and will cost £15.70 per child. This cost includes the coach (which has been partly funded by the PTFA) and the activity day at Cadbury's World. We will leave school at 8am and return at 4pm approx.

Your child will need a packed lunch and drink on the day (no bottles or chocolate please). I suggest they bring their lunch in a throw away bag to save carrying lunchboxes and bags. They will also need a coat. If your child suffers from travel sickness please ensure they have taken medication and they have some for the return journey, in a named envelope.

I do have space for 2 parent helpers to accompany us on this trip. However, there will be a cost of £10.70 as entry to Cadbury's World. If you are interesting in coming with us then please let me know asap, however if I am inundated with offers of help I will have to resort to the old fashioned 'pulling a name out of a hat' to be fair to everyone.
