Monnow Class Trip – Small Breeds Farm Park & Owl Centre

As part of this half term's Science topic, on Thursday 23rd March 2017, Monnow Class will be visiting the Small Breeds Farm Park & Owl Centre, Kington. The children will be departing at 9:30am and we will be learning about all of the different animals they keep on the farm. After lunch we will be feeding the animals as we walk around and will return to school for approximately 3.00pm.

The children will need to wear the top half of their school uniform with trousers, jogging bottoms or leggings (preferably in black) and a waterproof coat. They will also need sturdy shoes; either wellington boots or walking boots and a packed lunch (no sweets, glass bottles or fizzy drinks please). It would be useful if they could bring their lunch in a named lunch box, with plenty to drink during the day. Your child will be given the opportunity to visit the shop; however spending money should be no more than £3.50 and kept in a named wallet or purse. It will be your child's responsibility to look after their money.

If your child suffers from travel sickness, please can you ensure they have taken their medication before travelling and have medication for the return journey. Please hand these to Miss Glover in a named envelope on the day.
