Dear Parents,

We are getting very close to our PGL visit and we are all very excited.

I would be grateful if you could indicate below how your child will be getting to Tregoyd house. I have limited space in my car, but it would be preferable if you could organise with another parent if you are unable to transport your child to or from the venue.

Several children have asked if they are permitted to take cameras. As we are undertaking wet and messy activities, children should take disposable cameras only, in case of loss or damage. Please can I reiterate that phones and electrical gadgets are not permitted.

There is a tuck shop at PGL, where children can purchase sweets, so please could I ask that children do not bring too many snacks: they are not conducive to a good night's sleep and the days are very long at PGL!

As we are raft building, canoeing and undertaking the muddy challenge course, please ensure that your child has plenty of old clothes to change into, and they should bring a bin bag for wet, muddy laundry.

Finally, please could you provide me with written instructions for any medication which might be needed, and ensure medication is handed to me so that I can keep it safe. Please check inhalers are full and within date.

I recommend children bring a reading book, in case they are particularly early risers, or require a little down-time between activities.
