As part of this term's Science topic of Seasonal Changes, on Tuesday 1<sup>st</sup> November 2016, Monnow Class will be visiting Queenswood Country Park, Dinmore, Hereford. The children will be departing at 9:45am and we will be looking at the changing signs of Autumn by visiting the arboretum whilst appreciating the glorious nature which surrounds us.
