Dear Parents/Carers,

As part of this term's history topic, Wye Class will be visiting the National Roman Legion Museum in Caerleon, Wales on Thursday 6th October. The museum brings all of the features of Roman living in Britain, which we have been/will be learning about, into real life experiences.

The children will be travelling by coach and will be departing from school at 8:15am. Please ensure your child arrives at school at 8:00am prompt to allow time for registration and preparation for the trip (please note: this is too early for Breakfast Club to be able to provide food for your child). We will be returning back to school at approximately 4pm.

The children will need to wear their school uniform with sensible footwear, as some outside areas may be muddy, and a waterproof coat. They will also need a packed lunch (no sweets/chocolate, glass bottles or fizzy drinks please). It would be useful if they could bring their lunch in a named carrier bag which could be disposed of once they have finished eating. Your child will also be given the opportunity to visit one of the gift shops. Spending money should be no more than £3.50 and kept in a named wallet or purse. It will be your child's responsibility to look after their own money.

If your child suffers from travel sickness, please can you ensure they have taken their medication before travelling and have medication for the return journey. Please give this to Mrs Blenkinsop in a named envelope.

The cost of the trip and coach will be £11.00. I would be grateful if you could complete the payment via your ParentPay account by Friday 23rd September 2016. The PTFA have kindly donated towards the cost of this trip. Thank you.
