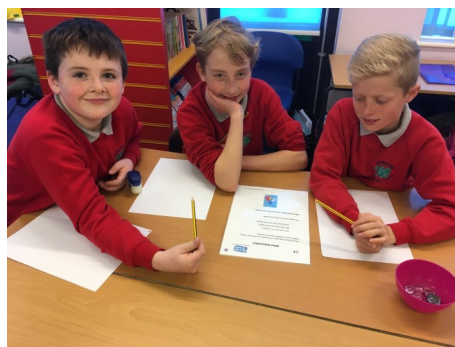
BOOKS GALORE
