# CHARITY

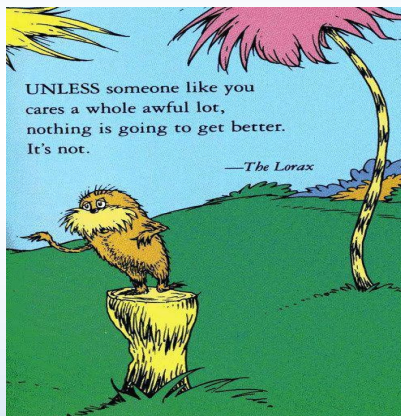


It is very sad that in the news there is lots of negativity and not a lot of good things happening, especially between people.
