PTFA COMMITTEE ROLES

It's the time of year to elect a new committee to steer the PTFA.

As a registered charity, we must fulfill certain requirements.

We are lucky enough to have amazing volunteers who get involved with running events, but without someone planning and doing the admin, we can't run any events to get involved with...

Chair: runs meetings, writes annual reports, is general point of contact for the committee and members of the school

Secretary/Vice-Chair: Organises, publicises and minutes meetings, and supports or deputises for the Chair

Treasurer: Manages the accounts and keeps up-to-date financial records and reports

In many ways, however, the roles above are the easy part! They can take up just a little time if we have plenty of 'ordinary' members who are committed and enthusiastic general members of the PTFA who can take charge of an idea and run with it. As well as a Chair, Secretary and a Treasurer, we need:

An Events Committee

A group of people who can plan, organise and mobilise volunteers for events

Publicity & Social Media

Someone to rock our Facebook page and be point of contact for communication

A Fundraising Committee

For grant applications, raffle prizes, 50-50 lottery and specific projects

You could have as many or as few roles as you can manage, and commit to just an hour a month or an hour a week. Everyone is busy, but many hands make light work (and fireworks happen, and Christmas magic, and summer fun...)
