

Herefordshire Libraries Summer Reading Challenge 2021



The Summer Reading Challenge, presented by The Reading Agency and funded by Arts Council England, encourages children aged 4 to 11 to set themselves a reading challenge to help prevent the summer reading 'dip'.

Each year the Challenge, delivered with the support of public libraries, motivates over 700,000 children to keep reading to build their skills and confidence.

How it works:

- Children visit their local Herefordshire library to pick up their Wild World Heroes collector bag.
- Children can read books of their own choice during the summer, adding special stickers to complete their folder and enjoy rewards along the way.
- Libraries offer FREE membership, new book titles and fun events to encourage families to take part.
- Children who take part in the Summer Reading Challenge can collect a certificate and medal from their library.
