## Wye Class Assembly

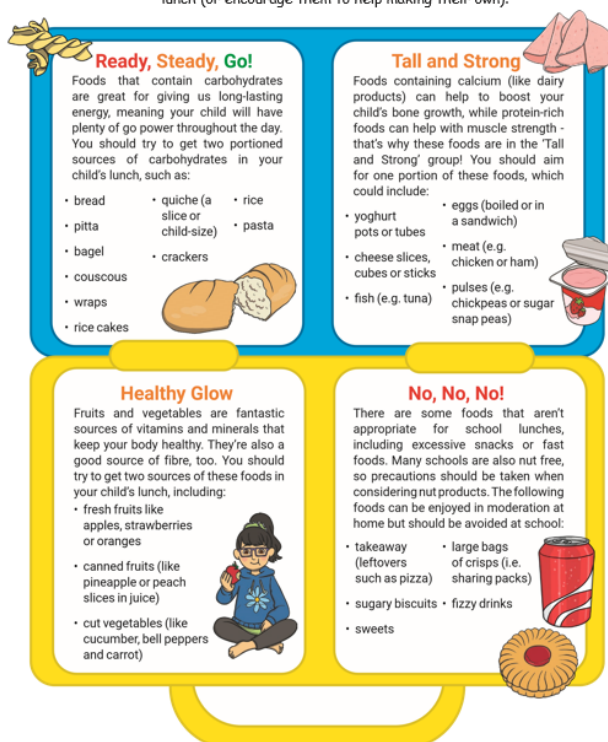
Wye Class delivered a super assembly about the Lord's Prayer on Thursday afternoon. Well done Wye Class.
