Adverse Weather

In the event of colder temperatures and snow-fall our aim will always be to remain open if possible. However, in the event of extreme conditions we may have to close the school. This decision will be based on safety: road conditions, ability to clear the site and adequate availability of staff.

You will be informed of school closures as soon as possible via the school website, Herefordshire Council website: school closure section (you are advised to sign up to their alerts) and Parent Pay. Where the school remains open it is down to each individual family to decide if your journey is safe.

School Closures 4th and 8th May 2023

As you may be aware Mordiford Primary School is regularly used as a Polling Station and has been booked for the General Election on **Thursday 4th**May 2023. Due to the implementation of the Elections Act next year the Local Authority have said the use of the Severn suite is no longer suitable and they will need use of our hall.

Keeping the school open with members of the public accessing the hall causes logistical problems with toilets, cloakrooms and lunches and also poses an unacceptable safeguarding risk to pupils.

Unfortunately we have had to make the decision to close the school to pupils all day on Thursday 4th May 2023. We will look forward to seeing everyone back in school on Friday 5th May which will be a normal school day.

King Charles' Coronation will be on **Monday 8th May.** This day will be a national holiday in the UK so the school will also be closed on this day.
