Library Dream Team

Thank you so much to all our parents who have been part of our library 'Dream Team' this week, cataloguing hundreds of books in our library. We have made excellent progress with more than half our fiction texts being catalogued and 'banded' (sorted by difficulty). Setting up this system will really help our KS2 children when choosing what to read, they will be able to go online from home and view our library virtually to research and reserve books they want to read in a 'band' that will be accessible to them.

We will be continuing to scan books next week, so if you feel you can help, please contact Miss Edmonds.

Alongside setting up the new library system, our KS2 children will be taking an online reading exercise to establish the suggested book bands they should choose books from. This online reading exercise, adapts to their answers (becoming more difficult when they answer correctly and easier if they answer incorrectly) to work out the band for reading. The system will help us track reading progress during the year.

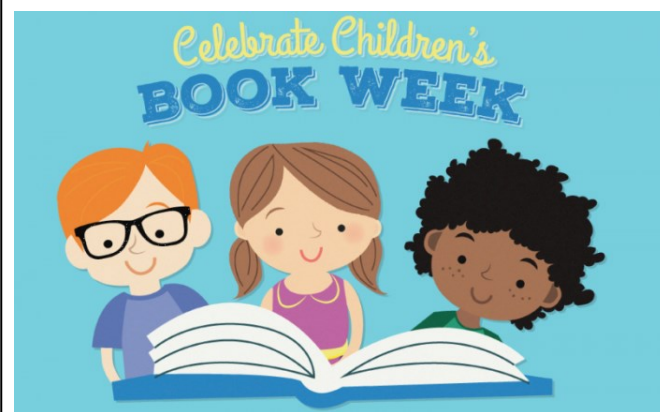
