



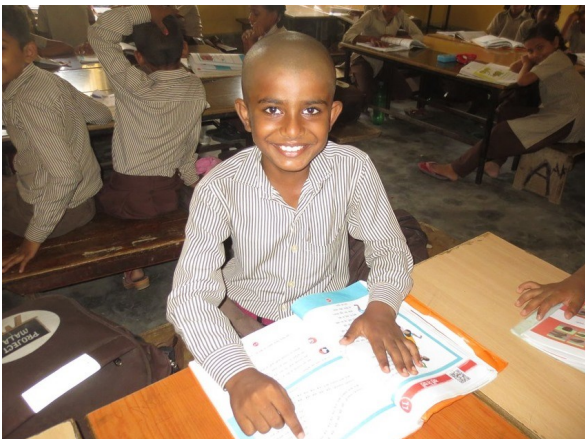
Project Mala

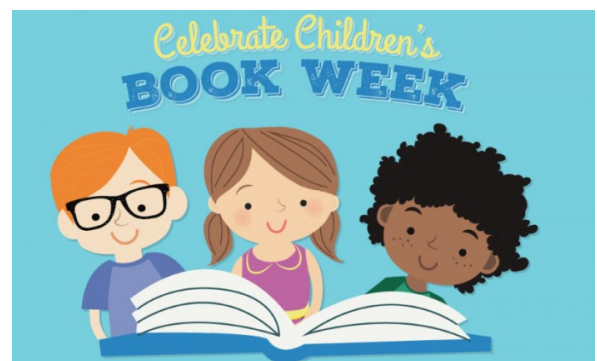
Book Week
