Teme Class Science Lesson

In Teme class this term, the children are learning about 'sound' in our Science topic. They had a very practical lesson this week to understand that sound is created when something vibrates and sends waves of energy to our ears. They used tuning forks to hear and feel the vibrations, and then put the tuning forks in a tray of water to see the vibrations moving. They also made paper cup and string telephones to talk to each other. The children realised that having the string taut made the sound louder; if we tied a knot in the string this stopped the vibrations travelling; if we made the string shorter

this also made the sound louder and we could still hear sound around a corner. It was a lot of fun!
