Following a meeting with the committee trustees and Mrs Warmington we wanted to give you an update on this years spending and the future of the PTFA.

### **This year's PTFA Contribution update**

Unfortunately, the Christmas theatre trips did not go ahead as there were no tickets available on the school's chosen dates. This week school are booking the Christmas trips for December 2023 to make sure they get their chosen shows.

The £1,860 that was allocated for this has now been put towards the following:

- New library software and accelerated reader £800
- iSing Pop £800 (**Concert will be Friday 14<sup>th</sup> July**)
- Remaining funds are being used for class resources £260

The £1,860 contribution from the PTFA for Summer trips remains the same. These have already been planned and children will be going to the following places:

- Thinktank in Birmingham (Y3 & Y6)
- Elan Valley Reservoir (Y5)
- The Black Country Museum (Y4 & Y2)
- Ludlow Castle (Reception & Y1)

Once transport arrangements are confirmed, the letters are sent to parents.

### **Future of the PTFA**
