#### End of day pick up

Thank you for your feedback about end of day. We have been monitoring the times that traffic starts to back up on the road (generally around 3:05-3:10pm). This week, we have been making a concerted effort to ensure the children are out on the car park by 3:15pm and no later.

Cars then start moving by 3:17 and usually all the children are gone by about 3:27pm.

Our aim is to minimise the number of cars that end up waiting on the road at any time.

### Parents you can help in the following way: If you arrive early:

- Please fill ALL the parking spaces (including staff spaces at the top of the car park) before starting to queue
- When all the spaces are full, please start the queue as close to the crossing point (where Mrs Warmington stands) as possible (don't worry if you are on the 'wrong side' at this point, we can sort that out when the children come out)
- Please move forward when a space becomes available
- Please avoid parking on the road between the entrance and exit points.
