Waterworks Museum Trip

Teme Class had a superb trip on Tuesday, visiting the Waterworks Museum.

They were thoroughly entertained and engaged by Ruth from Dwr Cymru Welsh Water. First, the children recapped on their science learning of the water cycle, learnt about filtration systems to make the water clean and worked as engineers to design a town with piping from the reservoirs, with cost implications!

Later, one of the highlights of the day was pond dipping where the children found creatures to identify using a microscope. They ended the day with a trip to the gift shop!

Norovirus

We have had several norovirus cases throughout school recently.

Please help to stop the spread by:

- washing your hands thoroughly using soap and warm water after using the toilet or having contact with a sick individual and before preparing and eating food.
- Keep your child off school until they have not been sick or had diarrhoea for 48 hours.
- Do not rely on alcohol gels instead of washing your hands, as these do not kill the virus
- washing any contaminated clothing or bedding using detergent at 60°C
- use bleach-based cleaners to disinfect surfaces.
