## Year 4 Bishops Wood Trip

On Monday, Teme Class thoroughly enjoyed a trip to Bishops Wood Environmental Centre in Shropshire, to support their science topic learning this term. The children explored three different areas on the site – the woodland, the meadow and the pond. They investigated each habitat to discover which invertebrates and vertebrates lived there. They used dichotomous keys to classify the animals they found. They also played a game imagining life as a honeybee : collecting pollen in the natural environment, then thinking about how they needed to adapt after new roads and a housing development were built. Staff at Bishops Wood were impressed with the children’s knowledge, we had a really informative day!

We attended a lovely class assembly from Reception on Thursday. They told the story of the Good Samaritan using actions which they all discussed and chose themselves.
